Iberdrola presents a pioneer robot to check wind turbines

The *Aracnocóptero* has been designed and developed by a Salamanca company and saves time and costs in mill checks by reducing downtimes

A new robot, the Eol6 *Aracnocóptero*, designed and developed by a Salamanca company, will save time and costs on the checks needed to check the wind turbine blades of wind farms.

Iberdrola and Arborea Intellbrid presented this robotic aircraft in the Sierra Dueña wind farm, belonging to the electric company, with which it will be possible to avoid the installation of a crane to carry out the erosion checks that the blades of the mills suffer annually because of the dust, wind and ice.

Juan Antonio García, head of

wind exploitation in the central area of Iberdrola, stressed that inspections are carried out once a year and with the robot increases reliability with respect to the review methods that require the placement of cranes. "In one morning, you can review this park that has 37 mills and save system downtime," he said. For his part, the president of Arborea, Carlos Bernabeu said that with this robot and its software "damage of 2 millimeters can be detected and preventive maintenance". Iberdrola wind farms in Castilla y León generate 25% of the country's production of this type of energy.
